➔ Eligibility and Qualifications

- A person who has completed (or is expected to complete before enrollment) at least 12 years of formal education, or has completed an entire course secondary education at the time of application;
- A non-Korean national whose parents are BOTH non-Korean nationals; and
- A person who meets at least one of the following language proficiency requirements.

| First semester Scholarship | Students who satisfy the minimum language test score | 30%~80% of tuition for the first semester 30% if student is from a country whose mother tongue is in English language. |
| GPA Based Scholarship | Students whose GPA of the previous semester is 3.5 or higher and satisfy TOPIK requirements | 20%~50% of tuition |
